- ◆ More than 300 volunteers provide care for more than 160 exceptional campers
- ◆ Volunteers are comprised of seasoned counselors, lifeguards, maintenance crew and kitchen workers
- ◆ Volunteer counselors provide one-to-one care to each camper
- ◆ On-site health care team available 24 / 7
- ◆ Wheelchair accessible
- ◆ Activities include horseback riding, arts & crafts, woodcraft, riflery, swimming, boating and campfire
- ◆ Interactive and entertaining theme each year

New and returning children and adults ages 9+ with mental and/or physical challenges attend *E.C. Week* at Camp Fatima each year. The severity of their mental and physical challenges varies significantly.

A *Camper Assessment Form* must be completed for each camper. The information provided on this form will be used to assess if your exceptional citizen is eligible to attend *E.C. Week*. This form is also used for returning campers to request an application for future years. Once it is determined your exceptional citizen is eligible, and when space becomes available, we will send you a comprehensive *E.C. Week* application to complete and submit for full acceptance.
